



Anti-Bribery Statement

The International Faculty CITY College is committed to applying the highest standards of conduct and integrity in its business activities in Greece and other locations of operation and, as such, does not tolerate bribery.

A bribe is a financial advantage or other reward that is offered to, given to, or received by an individual or company to induce or influence that individual or company to perform public or corporate functions or duties improperly.

Scope:

Applies to employees, officers, agents, consultants, workers, and any other persons or companies acting for or on behalf of the CITY College.

Key Principles:

- Employees and others (officers, agents, consultants, or any other persons or companies) acting for or on behalf of the International Faculty CITY College shall not make, solicit or receive any bribes or unauthorised payments.
- 2. The success of the International Faculty CITY College's anti-bribery approach depends on all employees and those acting for the University playing their part in helping to detect and eradicate any potential for bribery.
