VP & Class Representatives Elections

Elections period: October 20th - November 2nd

Vice President Registering / Petitioning for Office:

Candidates with intent to campaign for the VP position must file an application for election at the Department of Student Affairs.

- Applications for VP candidates can be submitted by October 22nd.
- Candidates have one week for campaigning (week 3)
- Elections will take place: October 29th to November 2nd

The Vice President:

- The Vice President shall support the President in achieving the Student's Union's objectives and be the Officer chiefly responsible for representing views and needs of Master level students.
- The Vice President typically sits on the following University bodies: Discipline committees for Master level students, International Faculty Learning and Teaching Committee.
- She/he has the responsibility to support Master level student experience by gaining and understanding student opinion and working with the appropriate departments of the University.
- Supports the success of student events. Communicates the Students' Union's activities to Master level Students. Assists the Department of Student Affairs with various activities.
