## Psychotherapist, Business Coach and Organisational Consultant

In this presentation, Mr. Naoum Liotas will present some theories around building trust within teams which is a prerequisite for teams to deal with conflict and change. He will share his experience and knowledge from Gestalt psychology and how insights on the human psyche can help organisations and practitioners evolve and become more efficient and humane. He will also present a case from a series of change management workshops which were held to support the restructuring of a multinational company with offices in Germany, Spain, Turkey, India, China and the USA.

Mr. Naoum Liotas started out his career as an Electrical & Computer Engineer and MBA graduate to later divert into a more humanistic path. He completed his studies in coaching and Gestalt psychotherapy and he currently works as a Gestalt psychotherapist and supervisor, business coach and organisational consultant. His private practice is based in London. He is an ECP (European Certificate of Psychotherapy) holder, MBACP reg. (Registered Member of the British Association for Counselling and Psychotherapy) and a full member and GPO (Gestalt Practitioner in Organisations) in EAGT (European Association for Gestalt Therapy).
